UNASHAMED | Evangelism Sermon Series

If you ask most Christians what the mission of the church is, evangelism (sharing their faith with others) usually ranks in the top 3 answers. However, most Christ followers don't engage in spiritual conversations that lead to decisions for Christ. In a study by Lifeway Research, they found 80% of those who attend church at least once a month believe it's their responsibility to share their faith with others, but 61% of those never actually do. Why such a low number?

There are a number of reasons for this lack of personal sharing. One is people are concerned about "breaking the rules" at work or school. Another is people don't want to offend others or injure friendships. The biggest reason is most Christians don't feel they have enough Bible knowledge to competently share their faith story. They feel unequipped. The purpose of this series is to eliminate those obstacles and help everyone at Central become confident and excited about sharing their story of faith with others.
