Answering the Call: Studies in Nehemiah

Part 5: Being a Team Player - Nehemiah 4:21-23; 5:14-19

Great _____ are great _____!

1. Nehemiah wasn't _____ the _____.

We worked early and late, from sunrise to sunset. And half the men were always on guard. I also told everyone living outside the walls to stay in Jerusalem. That way they and their servants could help with guard duty at night and work during the day. During this time, none of us—not I, nor my relatives, nor my servants, nor the guards who were with me—ever took off our clothes. We carried our weapons with us at all times, even when we went for water. (Nehemiah 4:21-23 NLT)

2. Nehemiah _____ extra _____.

The provisions I paid for each day included one ox, six choice sheep or goats, and a large number of poultry. And every ten days we needed a large supply of all kinds of wine. Yet I refused to claim the governor's food allowance because the people already carried a heavy burden. Remember, O my God, all that I have done for these people, and bless me for it. (Nehemiah 5:18-19 NLT)

In the closing verses of the chapter, he (Nehemiah) showed how he was willing personally to take on a greater burden than that which he asked of others. It is a classic illustration of the obvious truth that leadership means going further than those one is leading. -H.G.M. Williamson
